Note: SPED & ELL parents may choose the hybrid 2-days on site or remote learning; and PK parents may choose 4 days onsite or remote learning. If you choose the remote option, you are locked in for 2 marking periods.

Fairfield Township School Start Plan

- School reopening date: September 8, 2020
- Hybrid Instruction (Cohort A, B, C,): Remote Learning (Cohort D)
- Remote learning available as full-time option, registration is required
- Masks are required for students, staff, guests, and visitors
- The Sheppard Bus company will clean the busses every day
- Daily health screenings and temperature checks required for students and staff
- Enhanced and upgraded cleaning protocols will be used throughout the day
- COVID-19 protocols based on Department of Health and Governor's Guidelines
- Masks are part of the student uniform, must be worn in order to enter the bus and school, and parents are responsible for the uniform and masks



Staff and students will wear masks throughout the school day and maintain social distancing. It is suggested that younger students practice wearing masks for extended periods now.



Staff and students will be asked to wash their hands frequently. Security, safety, health, and cleanliness will remain top priorities.
